






2ND & BETTER A clean floor that allows color variation between the very white sapwood and very dark brown heartwood. Sound knots up to a 1/4" diameter are acceptable as is moderate mineral streaking. Color variation will vary upon production. Average board length is 33".



3RD GRADE Allows prominent natural variation in color, various imperfections and obvious character marks. Open knots permitted up to 1" in diameter that do not go through the board. Average board length is



GLACIER Character Grade flooring with a long average length. All character flaws and imperfections are permitted. This flooring will have extensive color variation. Pencil width knots are allowed to go all the way through the board. Average board length is 48".



PESHTIGO RIVER CHERRY Floor will contain 90% brown heartwood 2nd & Better grading applies to this grade. Average board length is 33".
