

SPECIFICATIONS

Maple specifications should list the required species, grade and thickness. A typical specification for your choice of maple should appear as follows:

Random Length Strip Flooring

A. Flooring shall be MFMA-RL (Random Length) Northern Hard Maple, 25/32" thick x 2-1/4" wide, Second and Better Grade; T & G and EM; grade marked and stamped as produced by an MFMA member manufacturer.

MFMA Finger Jointed Strip Flooring

B. Flooring shall be MFMA-FJ (Finger Jointed) Northern Hard Maple, 25/32" thick x 2-1/4" wide, Second and Better Grade; T & G and EM; grade marked and stamped as produced by an MFMA member manufacturer.


MFMA Parquet Flooring

C. Flooring shall be MFMA-PQ (Parquet) Northern Hard Maple, 7/16" thick, Second and Better Grade; fastened together in panels using mesh, tape or wire backing or paper facing; grade marked and stamped as produced by an MFMA member manufacturer.

MANUFACTURED EXPANSION SPACING

MCR (Moisture Compensation Ridge)

Optional "MCR" manufactured expansion spacing refers to hardwood flooring with the inclusion of a small, machined ridge included to separate flooring board side edges as shown below.
